DISCIPLING OTHERS

At the conclusion of Matthew in chapter 28, verse 18 we read:

“Then Jesus came to them and said “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you”.

Now that we know what a disciple is, what is required of one, and what we need to be doing to be growing in our walk with the Lord, we will now look our last topic which is discipling others. This lesson puts us in the 6th week of a six-week study on discipleship were we will wrap up our discipleship series.

We read in Mark 3:14 “*He appointed twelve – designating them apostles – that they might be with Him...*”

As Christian’s we are all called to discipleship. Once we have become a disciple and are doing the things necessary to grow as a disciple we need to begin to disciple others. In this lesson we will look at doing just that, discipling others. As we wrap our series of lessons on discipleship we will be looking at John 13: 1-17 and witness firsthand how we are to disciple others by following Jesus’ example. As we look at this section of scripture we will answer the following questions:

- A. What is the most important principle in discipling others?
- B. What is a key component in discipling others?
- C. What is the best way to disciple others?

Before we start, let’s **PRAY** and ask God’s Holy Spirit to open our hearts to receive His Word and to show us how to apply it in our life.

Let’s look at John, chapter 13. We see here Jesus discipling those that were His own by setting the ultimate example. Let’s look at the first principle set forth in the verse one and some related topics.
